

Do not lose your Medi-Cal!

Medi-Cal law has changed: You might have to fill out a new form – the Mid-Year Status Report (MSR) – to keep Medi-Cal.

You do not have to turn in the MSR **and you should not lose Medi-Cal if you do not** if you are:

- A child under 21,
- Getting Medi-Cal based on age or disability,
- The parent or guardian of a CalWORKs child,
- A woman getting Medi-Cal based on pregnancy, or
- A woman in the breast or cervical cancer program



You do not have to turn in **any** documents (proof of income, resources, etc.) with the MSR.

If you lose Medi-Cal for not returning the MSR, you can **still return it within 30 days of the termination** and your Medi-Cal could be reinstated. **No need to reapply!**

What can you do to make sure you keep Medi-Cal? **Make sure you tell the county if you move** – you will lose Medi-Cal if they do not have your correct address. And you still have to turn in the “Annual Redetermination” form when it comes.
