### WHAT ARE SPECIALTY MENTAL HEALTH SERVICES (SMHS) FOR YOUTH?

Mental health services provided through <u>county mental health</u> <u>plans</u> and are accessible to individuals under 21 who <u>meet</u> <u>the medical necessity criteria for</u> <u>specialty</u>

#### SPECIALTY MENTAL HEALTH SERVICES INCLUDE:

Intensive Care Coordination (ICC)

Intensive Home-Based Services (IHBS)

Therapeutic Foster Care (TFC) & Behavioral Services (TBS)

Individual Group & Family Therapy

Crisis Counseling & Stabilization Special Day Programs

Inpatient Hospital or other facility-based care and many other mental health services!

246,000 young adults (ages 0-20) rely on SMHS

- Youth ages 12-17 **experiencing major depression** increased between 2021-2022
- About 65% of youth with major depression did not receive mental health treatment
- 23% of youth (ages 0-20) suffer from reaction to severe stress, and adjustment disorders
