The California Department of Social Services estimates over 500,000 caregivers are enrolled as IHSS providers, supporting people with illness and disabilities to stay in their homes.


1 IN 5 adults are caregivers in California.

- <u>23%</u> are 65 years old or older

- **70-80%** of dementia caregivers are women


