## WHAT ARE SPECIALTY MENTAL HEALTH SERVICES (SMHS)?

mental health services that are more
intensive & supportive,
primarily for adults with serious mental
illnesses or disorders,
provided by county Mental Health Plans
(MHPs)

### SPECIALTY MENTAL HEALTH SERVICES FOR ADULTS INCLUDE:

Psychiatrist & Psychologist services Psychiatric inpatient hospital services

Psychiatric nursing facility services Targeted case management

**Rehabilitative** mental health services, medication **support**, day treatment intensive, crisis intervention/**stabilization**, and more.



#### In California



**5.8 Million adults** received SMHS (2021)

1 in 6 adults experience mental illness and 1 in 25 adults experience serious mental illness

Serious mental illness among Californians is higher and more common for those living in poverty.

Experiencing a mental health condition is a <u>major risk factor for suicide</u>. *Aging adults* **85+** have the **highest rate** of suicide in California.
